Free Home Repairs for Qualified Homeowners

Rebuilding Together Seattle is a non-profit organization dedicated to spreading the spirit of volunteerism through home repair and rehabilitation by helping low-income homeowners from Tukwila, SeaTac, Seattle to Everett. To qualify, homeowners must occupy their homes and show financial, physical or medical limitations that prevent them from carrying out the work themselves. Our area of focus is on supporting particularly seniors, disabled persons and families with children to ensure homeowner safety, security, independence and warmth.

Rebuilding Together Seattle is currently seeking applications from homeowners for both our Annual Spring (April) Rebuilding Day event in 2009. Although, it seems that April is a number of months away, we begin our home preview process in October and encourage you to apply early.

Since 1989, Rebuilding Together Seattle has rehabilitated 637 homes and non-profit facilities thanks to the help of over 20,400 volunteers and the financial support of our corporate sponsors and community donors. Volunteers complete projects such as: building new steps, replacing broken doors, installing hand rails, fixing gutter and downspouts, replacing broken appliances, hauling trash and debris, painting rooms and exteriors, and cleaning up yards.
